
2. This permit is being modified for the following reason:

Attachment A: Meadow Creek Allotment #20102 Billing Sequence

Herd size may vary depending on water availability due to climatic conditions, for up to 240 head months (HMs) across all land ownerships. Annual authorized HMs that are within estimated carrying capacities for each pasture are stated below. Capacities are estimates based on past AMP and range monitoring work. Flexibility to adjust numbers between scheduled use pastures can be authorized with prior approval as stated in Part 3, Management Practice #7 of the Term Grazing Permit. Average use based on the 5 year cycle for Forest Service lands is 124 Head Months (HMs). Livestock numbers, season of use, and modifications, if any, will be specified in the annual bill for collection and will generally follow the schedule below.
